- Five (5) years progressively responsible senior planner and leadership experience in development and/or land use planning, preferably at the local government level.
- Three (3) years recent progressive supervisory experience, preferably in a unionized environment.
- Excellent communication skills and analytic abilities, and a process-oriented mindset with the ability to interpret local government legislation, bylaws, and policies.
